

Rules and Regulations for Master Degree in Yoga

Application Procedure:

Please send the application with all attachments as mentioned in the check list by speed/registered post to the Principal, Indian Institute of Yogic Science & Research (IIYSAR) before the last date of submission of application or deposit in IIYSAR office. Before you send the hard copies please send the soft copies (jpg format) to us for quick response.

- I. Attach self-certified copies of mark sheet & certificates (Original/Provisional) of all examinations passed as per check list.
- II. All originals will be verified at the time of admission.
- III. Attach your Yoga experiences in a different sheet if needed.
- IV. The medical history has been asked to help you in practical training. Please attach medical (diagnostic) documents if you have.

V. Attach DD of Rs.300/- from any nationalized bank in favor of Indian Institute of Yogic Science & Research, payable at Angul.

Or

Deposit/online transfer Rs. 300/- in favor of "Indian Institute of Yogic Science & Research" Account No. 116010400002066 of IDBI Bank. IFSC IBKL0001295, MICR: 751259006. Attach the Deposit receipt / Transaction receipt.

VI. Declaration duly filled in.

Admission Procedure:

Written entrance & viva will be conducted after processing the applications if needed. Then selected candidates will be informed by email. Selected candidates will report IIYSAR office on the date and time of Admission with all Original documents and DD of course fee as mentioned in the check list. Both application and admission procedure are same for overseas candidates except the legal formalities. The overseas candidates should apply sufficiently before the session so that after processing the application they can apply for student visa.

Eligibility: Any Graduate from a recognized University having minimum 45% marks in aggregate (40% for SC/ST candidates).

Age Limit: No age limit.

Selection Procedure: Interview and Medical Fitness.

Entire Course Fees for 2 years: Rs.30,000/-(excluding hostel fees, examination fees etc.) for General Candidates & Rs. 21,000/- for SC/ST Candidates.

Hostel Fees: Rs. 3000/- per month for hostel accommodation & food (Two Veg. Meals per Day).

Examination:

The University Examination shall be conducted at the end of each Semester as notified by UUC. The Mid semester & Sessional Examination will be

conduct during the Semester as per the guideline of UUC. A candidate admitted to M.A. in Yoga course can complete the course over a period of 4 (Four) continuous academic years.

Syllabus: The courses of study as prescribed by Utkal University of Culture consist of total 100 credits of 2000 marks. The number of papers are 20.

Duration: 2 years (4 Semesters)

Number of Seats: 64 (Sixty-four)

General rules and Regulations:

This Gurukul Institution is running with the adaption of certain rules and regulations for the better educational environment. Yoga is a very serious subject and hence it will require complete dedication towards the study and time table. Students are required to have cordial relationship with all your fellow students, faculties and administrators.

- a) Student may require to participate in various activities conducted by the institute as the part of the curriculum (Like Red Cross, NSS, Seminars, Conferences and etc.).
- b) No intoxicant is allowed inside the Institute premises. Any one held using any kind of intoxicant shall be dealt as per law.
- c) Peaceful environment of the institute should be maintained at any cost. Anyone found indulged in any sort of illegal activities shall be dealt as per law.
- d) Karma Yoga (selfless service) of 30 minutes and Prayer for 30 minutes will be conducted daily.
- e) In any case the course fee will not refund to the student unless he/she cancelled the admission within 15 days from the date of admission with a genuine reason.
- f) In case of Transfer to other institute with a genuine reason during 1st year (1st/2nd semester) 50% of the course fee may be refunded. Any refund must be done by cheque or Online transfer. After 1st year or one year after the date of admission there will be no refund of course fee in case of transfer to other institute.
- g) The fee for applying for CLC is Rs. 100/-.

h) The fee for Mid- Sem Examination is Rs 200/- per each theory paper.

LIBRARY RULES

- i. Unless otherwise mentioned, books are issued for a period of 2 weeks.
- ii. Books may be renewed on request at the discretion of the librarian.
- iii. A fine of Rs. 5.00 will be charged per day if the book is kept overdue for the first seven days. Then onwards Rs. 10.00 per day will be charged.
- iv. Dog-earing the pages of book, marking or writing there in with ink or pencil, tearing or taking out its pages or otherwise damaging it, will constitute an injury to a book. Any such damage to a book is a serious offence, unless a borrower points out of the damage at the time of borrowing the book. He/she shall be required to replace the book.
